FILL IN WHAT YOU LEARNED

1. The Grand Canyon is 277 miles long, up to 18 miles wide, and over a mile deep — its exposed rock layers span nearly 2 billion years of geological history.
2. Arizona has the largest percentage of land designated as Native American territory of any state — about 27% of its total area.
3. The saguaro cactus, iconic to the Sonoran Desert, can live for over 200 years and grow up to 50 feet tall.
4. Meteor Crater near Winslow, Arizona is one of the best-preserved meteorite impact sites on Earth, nearly a mile wide and 550 feet deep.
