1. Colorado has 58 mountain peaks above 14,000 feet, the most 'fourteeners' of any state.

3. Denver's Coors Field has a row of purple seats in the upper deck marking exactly 5,280 feet (one mile) above sea level.
4. Mesa Verde National Park protects over 5,000 archaeological sites, including 600 cliff dwellings built by Ancestral Puebloans.
