FILL IN WHAT YOU LEARNED

1. Hawaii is the only U.S. state that grows coffee commercially — Kona coffee from the Big Island is among the most expensive in the world.
2. Mauna Kea, measured from its base on the ocean floor, rises over 33,000 feet — taller than Mount Everest from base to summit.
3. Hawaii has its own time zone (Hawaii-Aleutian Standard Time) and does not observe daylight saving time.
4. The Hawaiian alphabet has only 13 letters: 5 vowels (a, e, i, o, u) and 8 consonants (h, k, l, m, n, p, w, and the okina).
