1. About 95% of the world's bourbon whiskey is produced in Kentucky, aged in the state's limestone-filtered water and charred oak barrels.
2. Mammoth Cave is the world's longest known cave system, with over 420 miles of surveyed passageways — and new passages are still being discovered.
3. The Kentucky Derby, held the first Saturday in May at Churchill Downs, is the longest continuously held horse race in America (since 1875).
4. Both Abraham Lincoln (Union president) and Jefferson Davis (Confederate president) were born in Kentucky, about 100 miles and one year apart.
