1. Ohio has produced eight U.S. presidents: William Henry Harrison, Ulysses S. Grant, Rutherford B. Hayes, James Garfield, Benjamin Harrison, William McKinley, William Howard Taft, and Warren G. Harding.
2. The Wright Brothers were from Dayton, and Neil Armstrong (first person on the Moon) was from Wapakoneta, making Ohio 'the birthplace of aviation and space exploration.'
3. The Rock & Roll Hall of Fame is in Cleveland because DJ Alan Freed popularized the term 'rock and roll' while working at a Cleveland radio station in the 1950s.
