FILL IN WHAT YOU LEARNED

1. Utah has five national parks — Arches, Bryce Canyon, Canyonlands, Capitol Reef, and Zion — collectively known as the Mighty Five.
2. The Great Salt Lake is the largest saltwater lake in the Western Hemisphere, roughly 3 to 5 times saltier than the ocean.
3. The Bonneville Salt Flats are so flat that you can see the curvature of the Earth — land speed records have been set here since 1914.
4. Arches National Park has over 2,000 natural stone arches, the highest concentration in the world.
